MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

By a Declaration published in the Government Gazette by Notice 258 of the 26th of April, 1956, a plot of land was acquired at Bingemma, in the limits of Mgarr, Malta in connection with the construction of a water pumping station.

Following a further examination of the proposed construction it was found out that a larger area would be required and this explains why the former Declaration is being superseded by the attached Declaration.

The Acquisition is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the valuation report of the Land Engineer it emerges that the freehold value of the plot has been assessed at £222. 18s. 4d.

Hon. Ministers are asked to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Bingemma in the limits of Mgarr, Malta.

A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 4.4 Kejliet, bounded on the East by public road, on the South by property of Mrs. Josephine Calleja and others, on the South-Jest by property of Miss Maria Muscat and others and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Noble Frances Chesney.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 17/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration supersedes that published in the Government Gazette by Notice No. 258 of the 26th April, 1956.
