

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor deals with the acquisition of two small plots of land at "Tal-Hmis" in the limits of Gudja.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The plots are required for a public purpose in connection with road widening in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

No structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

The Land Engineer has estimated the freehold value of the two plots at £6.8s.0d.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at "Tal-Hmis" limits of Gudja:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1.3 kejllet, bounded on the South East by a public road and on the North and North West by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of St Augustine's Priory of Valletta.

2. A plot of land of the area of 3.5 kejllet, bounded on the South, South West and South East by a public road and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of Carmela Cachia.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 126/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
