MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance,

(Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor covers the acquisition of four plots of land in the limits of Siggiewi.

No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition and it is intended to acquire by way of absolute pruchase.

The four plots of land are required in connection with the widening of Providence Street, Siggiewi. The acquisition is for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

The Land Engineer has estimated the freehold value of the four plots at £66.16.0d.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

Declaration by the Governor

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Siggiewi:-

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 1.2 kejliet bounded on the North and East by Providence Road, on the South by property of Mr John Camilleri and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of the Rev. Father Joseph Ascolese.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 9 kejliet bounded on the North by property of the Reverend Father Joseph Ascolese, on the East by Providence Road, on the South-east by the property of the Parish Church of Siggiewi and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr John Camilleri.
- 3. A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan and 8.3 kejliet bounded on the East-north-east and on the South-east by Providence Road, on the South-west by Government property and on the North-west by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of the Parish Church of Siggiewi.
- 4. A plot of land of the area of 1.6 kejliet bounded on the North-east by Government property, on the South by Providence Road and on the North-west by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property of Miss Maria Delia.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 133/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
