

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chap.136)

The attached declaration covers a plot of land at Xaghra, Gozo. It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase. No structures are involved in the acquisition in question.

The plot of land is required in connection with the construction of a street between Gnien Emrik Street and Bullara Street, and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

It emerges from the valuation report of the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the property in question having regard to the sale of similar land on the open market and all other factors concerned at £357. 0s. 0d.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Xaghra, Gozo:

A plot of land of the area of 61 square canes, bounded on the North and on the South by the property of Mr Saviour Attard, on the East by Bullara Street and on the West by property of Mr Anthony Sultana; it is the property of Mr Joseph Mercieca.

The above plot of land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 209/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
