

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Chapter 136)

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two small plots of Land in the limits of Zebbug, Gozo.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The plots in question are required in connection with the widening of Marsalforn Road. The purpose of the acquisition is therefore a public one in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition Ordinance (Chapter 136).

No immovable structures are involved in the acquisition under review.

It transpires from the valuation of the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the two plots would amount to £12.16s.10d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zebbug, Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3.31 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mrs. Annetta Sultana on the East by Marsalforn Road and on the South by a passageway; it is the property of Mr. George Sultana.

2. A plot of land of the area of 4.4 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Anthony Sultana, on the East by Marsalforn Road and on the South by property of Mr. George Sultana; it is the property of Mrs. Annetta Sultana.

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 207/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
