

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
Chapter 136

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land at Luqa.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The acquisition involves part of a garden with door number 85 Gate Street, Luqa of the area of 3 kejllet.

The site in question is acquired for road widening and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provision of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

It emerges from the valuation report of the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the property in question amounts to £112.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa.

Part of a garden with door number 85, Gate Street, of the area of 3 kejllet; bounded on the North-East and on the West by Gate Street, on the South by premises No. 86, Gate Street, and on the South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which the said plot forms part, it is the property of Mr J. Costa.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.54/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
