The land under review is being acquired for the opening of a new street. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions - of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136.

The land engineer in his report assessed the freehold value of the land at £153.6s.8d.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Ghaxaq:-

A plot of land of the area of 23 square cames, bounded on the North by Zejtun Road, on the South by a new street which is projected to abut on Zejtun Road and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms parts; it is the property of Mrs Haria Busuttil.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 146/65 which may be seen on demand at the land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
