

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two immovable structures at Qormi consisting of premises No.5 and No.6 Alley 2, Barracks Street.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by Government in connection with a reconstruction scheme at Qormi and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

It emerges from the report submitted by the Land Engineer that following an inspection in situ and after taking into consideration the locality, as well as other factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property concerned the freehold value was assessed at £450; namely £350 in respect of premises No. 5, Alley 2, Barracks Street and £100 in consideration of premises No.6, Alley 2, Barracks Street, Qormi.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following premises at Qormi:-

1. Premises No. 5 Alley 2, Barracks Street; it is the property of Mrs Giuseppa Cassar and others.
2. Premises No. 6 Alley 2, Barracks Street; it is the property of Mrs Carmela Cilia.

The above mentioned premises are shown on a plan marked L.D.171/65 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
