

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two plots of land within the limits of Victoria Gozo.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The land is required by Government in connection with the construction of a new road and no immovable structures are involved. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136.

The freehold value of the land in question has been valued by the Land Engineer at £220.0s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Victoria, Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomna, 1 siegh and 5 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of the Cathedral Church of Gozo, on the West by property of Mr. Michael Angelo Vella and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Attard.
2. A plot of land of the area of 4 sieghan and 5 kejllet, bounded on the South by Racecourse Street, on the North by property of Mr. Carlo Galea and on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Attard.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 233/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
