

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purpose*) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at Zebbug, Malta.

Since the land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by outright purchase.

This plot of land is required for the purpose of road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £89. 4s. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zebbug ~ Malta:-

A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 4.6 kejllet, bounded on the South and on the East by Valletta Road and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmel Schiraha.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 235/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
