## MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

## Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of five premises at Cospicua.

These premises are required by the Government in connection with the Reconstruction Scheme for Cospicua; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

In view of the purpose for which the above premises are required, it is proposed that they be acquired by Government by way of public tenure.

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total recognition sent payable for the above five premises amounts to £127.8s.0d per annum.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.
