## MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at Mosta.

As this plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required by the Government for the purpose of widening Eucharistic Congress Road, Mosta; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to £770.18.8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend. 23rd July, 1966. Land 24/66

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

## DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Mosta:-

A plot of land of the area of 31.57 square canes, including part of a garage, bounded on the South-East and on the North-East by Eucharistic Congress Road and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part, it is the property of Mr. Joseph Camilleri.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 19/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
