

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to three plots of land at San Lawrenz, Gozo.

As these plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These three plots of land are required by the Government for the purpose of widening San Lawrenz Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the plots of land in question amounts to £30. 4.8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR - GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provision of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at San Lawrenz - Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 4.3 kejllet, bounded on the South by St. Lawrence Road, on the West by property of Mr. Joseph Grima and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part, it is the property of Mrs. Elizabeth Grima.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3.6 kejllet, bounded on the North by St. Lawrence Road, on the West by property of Mr. Lawrence Haber and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part, it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Tabone.
3. A plot of land of the area of 3.2 kejllet, bounded on the North by St. Lawrence Road, on the West by property of Mr. Gregory Cassar and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part, it is the property of Major Henry E. Sant Cassia.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 311/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
