Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a plot of land at Zejtun.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This plot of land is required in connection with the construction of an Electricity Substation; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the valuation report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the said plot of land amounts to £293.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zejtun:-

A plot of land of the area of 5.9 kejliet, bounded on the South-East by an Alley in Our Lady of Mercy Street, on the North-East, on the North-West and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Thomas Cauchi.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 323/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
