

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY- AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to premises at No. 27, St. Philip Street, Vittoriosa.

These premises were occupied by the Government on the 14th February, 1949; they have since been demolished and incorporated in a public square. As the Government requires these premises in connection with the reconstruction of Vittoriosa, they are required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

In view of the purpose for which these premises are required, it is proposed to acquire them by way of public tenure.

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer it transpires that the recognition rent of the above premises amounts to £5.12.0. per annum.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of public tenure.
