MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the equisition of two plots of land at Zurrieq, and it supersedes that published by Government Notice No.403 of the 16th August, 1963, is so far as Plot No. 1 in that declaration is concerned.

Since the land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

These two plots of land are required in connection with the Zurrieq Scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land $^{\rm A}_{\rm C}$ quisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold τ ue of the above two plots of land amounts to £1352. O. O.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zurrieq:-

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 674 square canes, forming part of the garden of premises No. 76 Queen Street, bounded on the . th by property of Mr. Joseph Attard and others, on the West partly by property of the Most Noble Count Notary Giovanni Chappelle Paleologo and partly by property of Mrs. Catherine Camilleri and others and on the East by property of Mr. Salvatore Saliba and others; it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Duca.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 137 square canes, forming part of the garden of "Palazzo Armeria", bounded on the North by property of Mrs. Giuseppa Attard and others, on the East by property of Mr. Emanuel Duca and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part and referred to as plot lA on the plan herein after mentiond; it is the property of the Most Noble Count Notary Giovanni Chappelle Paleologo.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan No. L.D. 79A/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published in the Government Gazette by Notice No. 403 of the 16th August, 1963, in so far as plot No. 1 in that declaration is concerned.
