

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Zebbug, Malta.

Since the said plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government in connection with the construction of a Civic Centre; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £1,156.5s.0d.

The attached Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 580 dated the 23rd August, 1966, in so far as plots Nos. 1 and 3 in that Declaration are concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

L-Arkivi Nazzjonali ta' Malta

The following land at Żebbuġ, Malta.

1. A plot of land marked 1 on plan, of the area of 77.5 square canes, bounded on the North by property of the Parish Church of Żebbuġ, on the East by De Rohan Street, and on the West by property of the same owner; it is the property of Mr Carmel Bugeja.
2. A plot of land marked 3 on plan, of the area of 8.1 square canes, bounded on the North by Paris Street, on the West by Sciortino Street, and on the East partly by property of the Parish Church of Żebbuġ and partly by property of the same owner; it is the property of Mr Carmel Bugeja.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 227A/65, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This Declaration is to supersede that published in the Government Gazette by Notice No. 580 dated 23rd August, 1966 in so far as plots 1 and 3 are concerned.
