

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 4 plots of land at Ghasri, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the 4 plots of land in question amounts to £108. 0. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Ghasri, Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 2.06 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by Wied Sara Street, on the South-East by property of Dr. Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D., and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Most Noble Baron Lino Testaferrata Bonnici.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 0.34 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by Wied Sara Street, on the South-East by property of Marquis Alexander Apap Bologna, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Dr. Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D.
3. A plot of land of the area of 4.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by Wied Sara Street, on the North-West by property of Dr. Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D., and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Marquis Alexander Apap Bologna.
4. A plot of land of the area of 7.5 Kejliet, bounded on the South-West by Wied Sara Street, on the North-West by a public road leading to Zebbug, and on

the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Major Henry E. Sant Cassia.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 218/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
