

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Qormi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with road formation; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £6,701.18s. 8d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 135) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Gormi:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 885.72 square canes, bounded on the North-West by Victory Street, and on the North-East and South-East by property of Dr Joseph Herrera LL.D. and others; it is the property of Mr George Berg.
2. A plot of land of the area of 285.79 square canes, bounded on the North by Tal-Glas Road, and on the East and South by Victory Street; it is the property of Mr George Berg.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 303/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
