

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Mgabba.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above two plots of land are required by the Government for the preservation Tal-Wilga Roman Tower; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the two plots of land in question amounts to £530.. 0..0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undersentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Mgabba:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 324 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Reverend Father Anthony Agius, on the East by property of Mrs. Ersilia England, and on the South-East by Hal Farrug road; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Vella.

2. A plot of land of the area of 423 square canes, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Carmelo Vella, on the East by property of the Noble Teuma Castelletti and others, and on the South-East by Hal-Farrug road; it is the property of Mrs. Ersilia England.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 149/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
