

MEMORANDUM TO C. BINET BY THE HON. MINISTER OF PUBLIC BUILDING & WORKS

Erection of a hotel at Fretty Bay, B'Bugia.

On the 10th Jānuary 1967, an application was filed with the Planning Area Permits Eoard for the erection of a hotel at Fretty Bay B'Bugia.

This application was discussed by the Town Planning Board who agreed that there should be no objection to the request provided height of building does not exceed 6 floors, two of which are to be reserved for bedroom accommodation. The relative Planning permit was issued on the 2nd September 1967.

On the 31st. July 1968, applicant requested the renewal of the permit.

Since the policy governing the height of buildings ~~has~~ since then been changed, Hon. Ministers are kindly requested to decide, whether permit should be renewed the old conditions subject to or whether any new conditions, limiting height, should be imposed.
