

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE (CAP. 136)

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Marsascala.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government for the construction of a bus shelter; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the two plots of land in question amounts to £291.12s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Marsascala:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 41.4 square canes, bounded on the North by Mifsud Bonnici Square, on the West by property of Mr Maurice Degiorgio, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Gabriel Degabriele.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2.34 square canes, bounded on the North by Mifsud Bonnici Square, on the East by property of Mr Gabriel Degabriele, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Maurice Degiorgio.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 281/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
