

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY

AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Zurrieq. This Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 772 of 1966 in so far as plot No. 1 in that Declaration is concerned.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This land is required by the Government in connection with the Zurrieq Scheme; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the plot of land in question amounts to \$540. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zurrieq:-

A plot of land of the area of 324 square canes, forming part of the garden of premises No. 76, Queen Street, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Joseph Attard and others, on the west partly by property of Count Notary Giovanni Carmelo Chapelle and partly by property of Mrs. Catherine Camilleri and others, and on the East by property of Mr. Salvo Saliba and others; it is the property of the heirs of the late Emanuel Duca.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 79F/65, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This Declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 772 dated 11th November, 1966, in so far as plot 1 is concerned.
