

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY

AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 8 plots of land at Luqa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said land is required by the Government in connection with the widening of Gudja Road, Luqa; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the 8 plots of land in question amounts to £1,228. Os. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Gudja Road, Luqa:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 kejllet, bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the South-East by property of Mrs Grazia Debono, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Maria Carmela Schembri.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3.6 kejllet bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the South-East by property of Mr Carmelo Schembri, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Grazia Debono.
3. A plot of land of the area of 3.5 kejllet, bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the South East by property of Mr Carmelo Fenech, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmelo Schembri.
4. A plot of land of the area of 4.5 kejllet, bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the South-East by property of Mr Carmelo Schembri, and others, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmelo Fenech.
5. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 1.5 kejllet, bounded on the North-East and North by Gudja Road, on the South-East and South by property of Mr Carmelo Pace, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmelo Schembri and others.
6. A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan, bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the North and North-West by property of Mr Carmelo Schembri and others, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmelo Pace.
7. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomna, 4 sieghan and 3 kejllet, bounded on the North-East by Gudja Road, on the East by an alley, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.
8. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 7.7 kejllet, bounded on the South-West by Gudja Road, and on the North, North-East and South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 321/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
