

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Santa Venera.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the construction of the Hamrun By-Pass; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £2,864. 3. 0d.

The above Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 330, dated the 15th April, 1969, in so far as Plot No. 8 is concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Santa Venera:

A plot of land of the area of 1 Tonna, 2 Sieghan and 6.4 Kejllet, bounded on the North-North-East by Santa Venera Street, on the South-South West by property of Miss Mary Grech and others, and on the East-South-East by property of Mr. Anthony Pace.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 140/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 330, dated 15th April, 1969, in so far as plot 8 is concerned.
