

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Zejtun.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for a Housing Scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £2,930. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zejtun:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 7.3 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property in course of acquisition by Government, on the North-East by property of Mr. Michael Caruana and on the South and South-West by property in course of acquisition by Government.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 2.4 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property in course of acquisition by Government, on the North-East by property of Mr. Michael Caruana and on the South West by property of the Cathedral Chapter and others.
3. A plot of land of the area of 18 Tumoli, 3 Sieghan and 2.4 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by a road, on the West, South-West and South by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the North-East by property of the Reverend John Briffa Brincati.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 12/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
