OPM/4/4/57/ii Airfares.

Ministers noted that BEA had implemented an increase in air fares and directed that all restrictions on Charter flights should be immediately removed.

OPM 519/69 Marshall Courts.

The Cabinet considered the effect of a strict application of the points system in regard to Marshall Court on the social environment which should ideally prevail in such a large building which would accommodate some 57 families and approved a suggestion that the Minister of Justice and Parliamentary Affairs

Should not be guided solely by a strict application of the points system in order to enhance the social environment at Marshall Courts.
