

Memorandum for the Cabinet

Appointment of member of the Land  
Arbitration Board

1. On termination of the appointment of Professor J.L. Gatt as the member, (being an architect not in the employment of the Government), of the Land Arbitration Board, it was expressly provided that Professor Gatt was to continue to hold his appointment in those matters, still pending before the Land Arbitration Board, in regard to which he had already held an inspection of the tenement.

2. Professor J.L. Gatt has now asked, owing to ill-health, that he be exonerated from his appointment in regard to such of the said cases as have not been yet decided, and has resigned.

3. The ordinary member, (being an Architect not in the employment of the Government), at present sitting on the Land Arbitration Board is Mr Joseph Attard, A.& C.E., and the Minister of Justice, therefore, recommends that Mr Attard's appointment be extended to include the matters in regard to which Professor Gatt has resigned. Hon. Ministers are asked to advise the Governor accordingly.
