

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET
BY THE HON. THE PRIME MINISTER

Air Transport Licensing Authority

Regulation 4 of the Air Transport (Licensing of Air Services) Regulations, 1949, published by Government Notice No. 219 of 1949 states that the Licensing Authority shall consist of such number of members, not being less than three, as the Governor may from time to time determine.

2. By Government Notice No. 628 of 1961, the following members were appointed for a period of one year:

The Chief Secretary - Chairman
The Director of Civil Aviation
Mr Anthony Camilleri (Comptroller of Customs)

The Director of Civil Aviation was also appointed to act as Secretary to the Authority.

3. It is proposed that the membership of the Authority should be enlarged and that it should be constituted as follows up to the 31st December, 1963:-

The Administrative Secretary - Chairman
The Director of Civil Aviation
The Comptroller of Customs
The Director of Industrial Development
The Chairman of the Malta Government
Tourist Board

The Director of Civil Aviation to act also as Secretary of the Authority.

4. Hon. Ministers are asked whether they agree to the constitution of the Authority as proposed in the preceding paragraph.
