

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Certain changes have been effected in structure of the Department of Trade and Industry. The post of Director of Industrial Development has been abolished and the duties inherent to that office have been divided between the Director of Industry and the Director of Trade.

This change brought about the necessity of adapting section 24 of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance Cap. 122.

AN ACT further to amend the Import and Export Duties Ordinance Cap. 122.

Short title and construction.

1. This Act may be cited as the Import and Export Duties (Amendment) Act, 1964 and shall be read and construed as one with the Import and Export Duties Ordinance hereinafter referred to as "the principal law".

Amendment of section 24 of the principal law.

2. In paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 24 of the principal law for the words "Director of Industrial Development" there shall be substituted the words "Director of Industry".

Objects and Reasons

The purpose of this Bill is to adapt the designation of the Director of Industrial Development in the principal law in view of the changes effected in the structure of the Department of Trade and Industry. The post of Director of Industrial Development has now been abolished and the duties inherent to industry have now been assigned to the Director of Industry.
