## Memorandum by the Minister of Justice Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to two plots of land within the limits of Lejtun.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase. The plots are required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136 inasmuchas they are required for the construction of a children's playground at Zejtun.

No is movable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It emerges from the valuation report drawn up by the Land Engineer that after taking into consideration the locality as well as the factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property in question its freehold value amounts to £148.6s.8d. Funds are available under Head 52 - 1 (Children's Playground).

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

## Description of the Land

The following land at Zejtun.

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomna 2 sieghan and 6 kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr Carmelo Zammit, on the East by property of the Parish Church of Zejtun and on the West by property of the Reverend Giovanni Palmier; it is the property of Miss Molly Curmi.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 5 kejliet, bounded on the East by property of Miss Molly Curmi, on the North and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Reverend Giovanni Palmier.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked 1.D.51/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
