

MEMO TO CABINET

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Agriculture, Power and Communications on the problem of offering employment to Unestablished Clerks recently discharged by the Navy Department Ministry of Defence

Twelve Unestablished Navy Department Clerks who have been discharged request Government to offer them employment.

.... The Clerks in question (a list is attached) have long and sound clerical experience, most of them are married and deserve Government's help.

It must be made very clear that it is not advisable to offer clerical Government employment to these Clerks. Government could help by taking back Government Clerk Typists seconded for duties with the Gozo Civic Council (1), Malta Broadcasting Authority (2), Malta Government Tourist Board (5) and Malta Electricity Board (1 C/T and 3 C.Os.).

The authorities concerned would then be able to employ these Clerks with them.

Hon. Ministers may wish to agree to this proposal.
