

Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land within the limits of Gudja.

It is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase. The land is required for the erection of an electricity sub-station and consequently for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136.

No immovable structures are involved in the proposed acquisition.

It emerges from the report by the Land Engineer, having regard to the value of the land if sold on the open market and all other factors concerned, that the freehold value of the property under review amounts to £41.5s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Gudja:

A plot of land of the area of 11 square canes, bounded on the South-South-East by Olive Street on the North-North-West and on the East-North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmel Farrugia.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 104/65 which may be seen on request at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
