Memorandum by the Hon. Minister of Justice Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136

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The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers a plot of land within the limits of St. Julian's.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase. The site is bounded on the South East by St. Andrew's Junction and leads into St. Andrew's Road.

No immovable structures are involved in the acquisition under review. The land is required by Government to incorporate it in a public road and therefore, for a public purpose in accordance with the provision of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

The Land Engineer has certified that, following an inspection in situ and after taking into consideration the locality as well as other factors which could have a bearing on the value of the property in question, the freehold value of the plot in question is to be valued at £3,065. Os. Od.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I haveby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at St. Julians:

A plot of land of the area of 5 sieghan and 7.4 kejliet, bounded on the South-East by St. Andrews Junction on the South-West by an unnamed street between St. Andrew's Junction and St. Augustine Street and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Francis Mamo and Mr Joseph Buttigieg.
