Memorandum by the Minister of Justice

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Acting Governor-General covers a plot of land within the limits of Zurrieq. It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The land is required by Government for the installation of a water-booster. It is therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions contained in the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

The Land Engineer has assessed the freehold value of the strip of land under review in respect of the utile and directum dominium at £4.6s.9d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

9th December, 1965. L/811/62 I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zurrieq:-

A plot of land of the area of 11.1 square canes, bounded on the North-East by a public road, and on the South and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part; it is the property as regards the Directum Dominium of the Domenican Friary of Rabat and of Mr Francis Schembri as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 241/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
