

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to five plots of land at Luqa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by title of absolute purchase.

This land is required by Government in connection with the formation of streets surrounding the children's playground at Luqa and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report submitted by the Land engineer, it transpires that the freehold value of the above five plots of land amounts to £222.12s.0d

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 5.6 Kejllet, bounded on the North, on the East and on the South-East by property in course of acquisition by Government, on the North-West by property of Mr Joseph Fiott and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin;

2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 9.4 Kejllet, bounded on the East and on the North-East partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and partly by property of Mr Raffaele Dalli and others, on the South-East by property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin and on the North-West and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Fiott;

3. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 1 Kejla, bounded on the North-West partly by Borals Alley and partly by property of Mr Carmel Seychel, on the South-West partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the North-East by property of Mr Andrew Scicluna; it is the property of Mr Raffaele Dalli and others;

4. A plot of land of the area of 6.5 Kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr Raffaele Dalli and others, on the South-West by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the East by property of Mr Andrew Scicluna; it is the property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin;

5. A plot of land of the area of 6.5 Kejllet, bounded on the West partly by property of Mr Guglielmo Bondin and partly by property of Mr Raffaele Dalli and others on the South-East by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Andrew Scicluna.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 75/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
