

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE (CAP. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to premises at No. 4, Church Alley, Attard.

Since the premises in question are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

These premises are required by Government in connection with the opening of a new street and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report submitted by the Land Engineer, it transpires that the freehold value of the above premises, having regard to its value if sold on the open market and to all other factors concerned, amounts to £200. 0s. od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.
