

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY  
AFFAIRS

A Bill entitled an Act further to amend the Cattle Breeding Ordinance, Cap.155.

According to the Cattle Breeding Ordinance, the Director of Agriculture is to publish once yearly in the Government Gazette a list of bulls available for breeding purposes, which list is to contain several particulars such as the breed, the place where the bull is kept, the address of the owner, the date of the issue or renewal of licence, etc.

The Administrative Secretary has enquired whether the publication of such list, which causes pressure of work on the Government Printing Staff, may be done away with.

The attached Bill seeks to remove the necessity of the publication of the list in the Government Gazette and to provide for the affixing of the list on the notice-board of the Department of Agriculture.

Honourable Members are invited to approve this Bill so that it may be presented to Parliament.

AN ACT further to amend the Cattle Breeding Ordinance, Cap.155.

BE IT enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives of Malta, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Cattle Breeding (Amendment) Act, 1966, and shall be read and construed as one with the Cattle Breeding Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law".

Amendment of section 5 of the principal law.

2. In section 5 of the principal law, for the words "The Director shall publish in the month of July of each year" there shall be substituted the words "The Director shall, in the month of July of each year, affix to the notice-board of his Department".

Objects and Reasons

The purpose of this Bill is to remove the necessity of publishing annually in the Government Gazette a list of bulls available for breeding purposes.
