MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the acquisition of a plot of land at Safi.

Since the plot of land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This land is required in connection with the preservation of a historical monument; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the said plot of land amounts to £84.11s.10d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition therefore is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Safi:-

A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna, 1 Siegh and 1 Kejla, bounded on the North, on the South, on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such a plot forms part; it is the property of the Archbishop's Seminary - Floriana.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 352/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
