ABILL entitled

AN ACT further to modify the application of section twenty-nine of the Constitution of Malta.

BE IT ENACTED by the queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives of Malta, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution of Malta (Application of Section Twenty-nine) Act, 1966.
- (2) Paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) of section 2 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of May, 1966, the 30th day of September, 1966, the 4th day of October, 1966, and the 30th day of November, 1966, respectively.
- Extension of 2. Section 29 of the Constitution of Malta shall application of also apply to section 29 of
 - (a) Guyana;
 - (b) Botswana;
 - (c) Lesotho;
 - (d) Barbados.

Objects and Reasons

The object of the present Bill is to provide for the inclusion of certain newly-independent members of the Commonwealth in the list of countries whose citizens, in accordance with section 29 of the Constitution of Malta, are conferred the status of Commonwealth citizens.
