

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Żżebbiegħ, in the limits of Imġarr, Malta..

Since the plot of land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government for the formation of a public open space; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £445.9s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Żebbiegħ, limits of Mgarr - Malta.

A plot of land, of the area of 5 Tumoli, 3 Siegħan and 5 Kejllet, bounded on the South by Government property and on the North, on the East and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Pio Zammit and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 27/67 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
