## MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Mellieha, the directum dominium of one of which belongs to the Government.

Since the said plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above two plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of the Mellieha By-Pass; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of one of the above plots amounts to £281.6s.8d, while the value of the Utile dominium of the other plot amounts to £516.13s.4d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes)Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

## Description of the land

The following land at Mellieha -

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Tumoli,
  3 Sieghan and 1 Kejla bounded on the North by Mellieha
  Road and on the South and South East by the remaining portion
  of the land of which this plot of land forms part: it is
  the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 6 Tumoli and 4 Sieghan bounded on the East by property held by the War Department, on the North, on the South and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Dr F. Pilzer and others as regards the Temporary Utile Dominium and of the Malta Government as regards the Directum Dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 58/67 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
