

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Nadur, Gozo.

As this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government for the erection of a public convenience; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £336.14.4.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Nadur, Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 31.99 square canes, bounded on the South by property of Assunta Borg, on the North partly by property of the Malta Electricity Board and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part, and on the East by North Street, it is the property of Salvatore Borg and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 78/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office 29, South Street, Valletta.
