SALARY ADJUSTMENTS

Consequent on the assurance given to some Associations to the effect that Government was at liberty to go to the Independent Commission with salary offers higher than those already granted, a certain number of adjustments has had to be made to re-adjust the relativities which were disturbed by the concessions made to Postal Grades following the strike by Post Office employees.

The attached schedules contain the proposed "improved" offers, which Honourable Ministers are requested to approve.
