

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises Nos. 66, 67 and 68, St. Helen Street, Birkirkara.

Since the said premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above premises are required by the Government in connection with the improvement of the approaches to the Parish Church of Birkirkara; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the premises in question amounts to £1,800. Os. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
