## MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at St Julians.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The two plots of land in question are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the said two plots of land amounts to £5,582.10s. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

## Description of the Land

The following land at St Julians:-

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 553.6 square canes, bounded on the North and West by Birkirkara Road, and on the South by property of the heirs of the late Joseph Dingli; it is the property of Mr John Debono and others.
- 2. A plot of land of the area of 145 square canes, bounded on the West by Birkirkara Road, on the North by property of Mr John Debono and others, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Joseph Dingli.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.163/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office 29, South Street; Valletta.
