

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land at Rabat/Dingli.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of the Rabat-Dingli Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the seven plots of land in question amounts to £179. 1s. 3d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Rabat/Dingli:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 9.4 Kejliet, bounded on the South by a public road, and on the West and North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.

2. A plot of land of the area of 3.2 Kejliet, bounded on the North and West by a public road, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Dr. Anton Caruana LL.D.

3. A plot of land of the area of 4.6 Kejliet, bounded on the North and West by a public road, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Paul Galea.

4. A plot of land of the area of 1.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North and West by a public road and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.

5. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 1.1 Kejliet, bounded on the North and West by a public road, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.

6. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 5.3 Kejlist, bounded on the North, West and South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Carmelite Convent of Rabat.

7. A plot of land of the area of 7.28 Kejlist, bounded on the North and West by a public road, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of St. Francis Church of Rabat.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 62/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
