Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the release of a plot of land at Marsaskala.

The plot of land in question had been declared to be required for a public purpose by the competent authority by means of a Declaration signed by His Excellency the Governor-General on the 2nd February, 1967, and published in the Government Gazette on the 10th February, 1967.

As the said plot of land is no longer so required, the attached Declaration is intended for its release.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

Whereas by declaration dated 2nd February, 1967, published in the Government Gazette of the 10th February, 1967, under Notice No. 102, His Excellency the Governor-General had declared the undermentioned land to be required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and whereas the undermentioned land is no longer so required, I hereby declare for all intents and purposes of law, that the undermentioned land is no longer required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Ordinance.

Description of the Land

The following land at Marsascula:

A plot of land of the area of 1402 square canes, bounded on the North and on the East by St. Theresa Street, on the South by Parish Square and on the West by Żabbar Street; it is the property of St. Philip Church of Senglea.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 111/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
