

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land in the limits of Mdina.

Since the above plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The plots of land in question are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the said two plots of land amounts to £135. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Ta' Bestia and Il-Hodba ta' Zokria limits of Mdina.

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 6 kejllet, bounded on the East and South by a road, and on the North and North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of the late Mrs Mary Schembri.
2. A plot of land of the area of 4 sieghan and 2 kejllet, bounded on the North, North-West and West by a road and on the South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Carmelite Convent of Mdina.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.230/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
