

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Marsa.

Since the above plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the extension of the Marsa Industrial Estate; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £340.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Marsa:

A plot of land of the area of 3 Tmien, 2 Sieghan and 3 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West by property of Marquis John Scicluna, on the North-East by property of Mr Joseph Mifsud and on the South-East by property of Dr Leslie Grech and others; it is the property of uncertain owners.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 29/68 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
